IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: September will mark a new school year and a fresh start after, one hopes, refreshing summer holidays for all. There will be a few changes beginning in September which I hope will continue to help us answer our common call to serve God, one another and the community we live in:

- The 10am service on the second Sunday of the month will return to the pre-Covid pattern of being a service of the word - i.e. there will be no Eucharist. This is to help us do two things: Firstly, to help make the Baptism services more engaging for both visitors and the regular congregation - despite our best efforts to encourage them to come forward, many visitors are effectively segregated away by Communion which is less than ideal and we are often pressured for time at the end. Secondly, it will give us room to have more variety within that service, in terms of liturgy, worship, prayer and preaching (e.g. it would be great to recite or sing the *Venite* or other psalms and canticles or to have time for more creative times of intercession or worship than we currently can.)
- From 2027 we will restrict Baptisms to the 2nd Sunday of the month in January, March, May, July, September and the first Sunday of November (because of Remembrance!). This means we will have less Sundays with baptisms than this year.
- Our Tuesday morning prayer meeting will move from Tuesday at 10am to Mondays at 10am with effect from September 7th.
- Our trial of two Simple Praise services a month will now become a permanent arrangement.
- Our weekly Thursday Eucharist and 8am BCP Sunday Communion will remain unchanged together with our monthly Messy Church service.

As with any changes, some will welcome these and others less so, but I really hope all will ultimately benefit and that we'll continue to experience God's blessing in ever increasing measure. Blessings, Yann.
