

ALL SAINTS PARISH CHURCH

The churchyard at all Saints Headley is one of the largest in Guildford Diocese. It is the duty of the parochial Church Council to preserve the essential character of this Holy place as a fitting place to commemorate the dead.

For this reason there are rules laid down by the Diocesan commissioners governing the use of the churchyard.

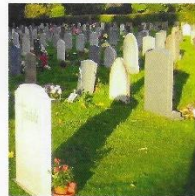
No monument or gravestone may be placed in the churchyard except with written authority of the Chancellor of the diocese. The form of a headstone as regards stone and lettering are available on request.

No order should be placed before this permission is given.

Please observe these rules:

- Ornaments, candles, statues, lights or similar objects are not permitted.
- A single sunken vase may be put on a grave, preferably in the centre of the plot.
- Seasonal bulbs may be planted directly into the ground.
- Wreaths and fresh flowers may be placed on graves but these will be removed when they deteriorate.
- Planted containers are not permitted.
- Good quality silk flowers may be used but these will be removed after two months.

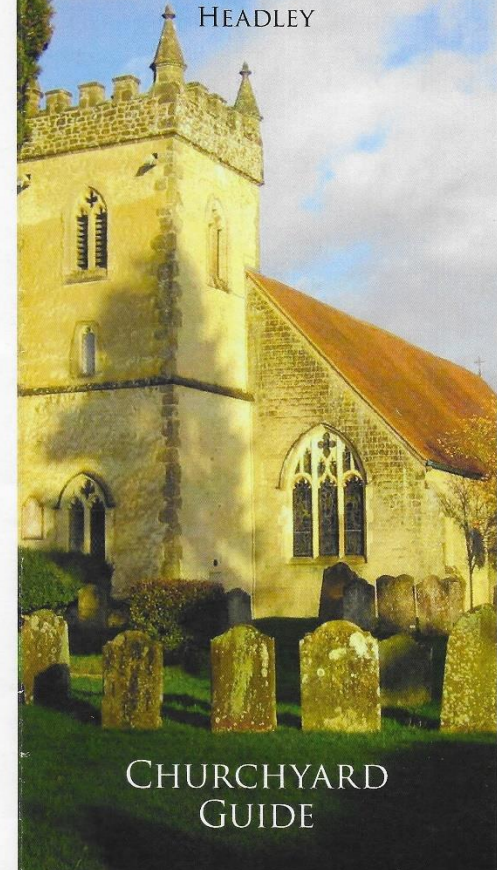
